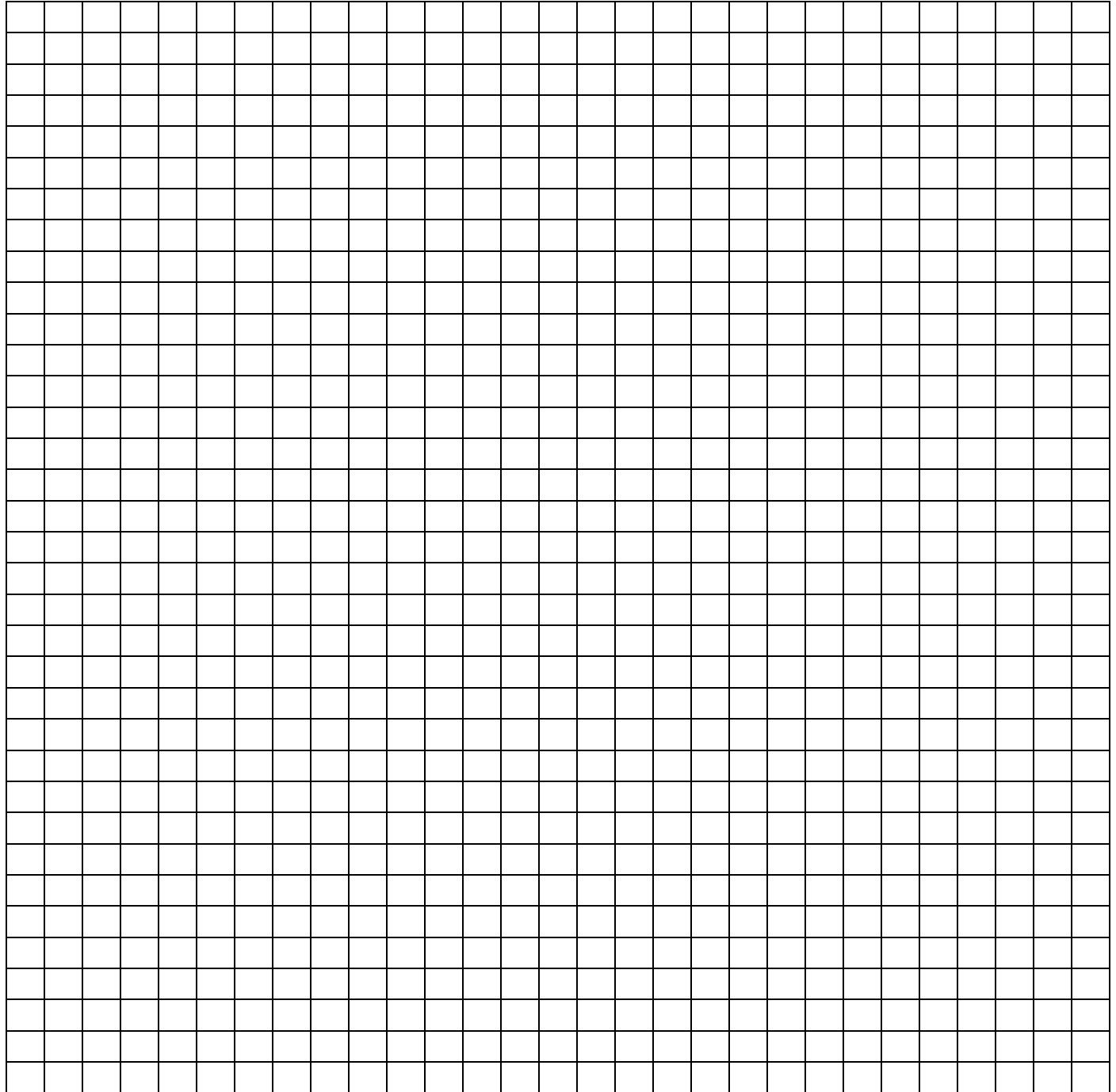


DIRECTIONS: PROPERTY MUST BE SHOWN ON DIAGRAM

Using a scale of 5' for each large square, make a line drawing in ink of your lot and proposed building, showing entire exterior dimensions and all clearances between lot lines and proposed building. Please indicate North, and the names of the adjacent streets. Also show all proposed porches, garages, etc. that are concerned with this permit. Any changes which you wish to make concerning any of the dimensions on this drawing will necessitate a new permit.



G. Fees. Each applicant for a building permit shall pay the City a fee to be determined as follows:

0 to \$50,000 estimated cost of construction	\$ 15.00
\$50,001 to \$100,000 estimated cost of construction	\$ 25.00
\$100,001 to \$500,000 estimated cost of construction	\$ 50.00
Over \$500,000 estimated cost of construction	\$100.00

A receipt for such fee shall be issued to the applicant. No part of the fee shall be refunded to the applicant when a permit is not granted.

NOTICE TO ALL POWER SUPPLIERS AND POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS IN THE STATE OF NEBRASKA

REVISIONS WERE MADE IN THE 1993 SESSION OF THE NEBRASKA LEGISLATURE RELATING TO ELECTRICAL INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS FOR PERSONS INSTALLING ELECTRICAL WIRING IN THE STATE OF NEBRASKA. THE REVISIONS TO THE STATE ELECTRICAL ACT BY LEGISLATIVE BILL 193 WILL HARMONIZE PROVISIONS OF ELECTRICAL INSPECTION THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

RESIDENTIAL ELECTRICAL INSPECTION REQUIRED

- (1) In addition to all Commercial, Industrial, and Public-Use installations, electrical inspection will now be required on all **RESIDENTIAL INSTALLATIONS WHEN NEW SERVICE EQUIPMENT IS INSTALLED.**
- (A) WHEN NEW SERVICE EQUIPMENT IS INSTALLED FOR A NEW RESIDENCE, AN INSPECTION IS REQUIRED ON THE ENTIRE WIRING INSTALLATION.
- (B) WHEN NEW SERVICE EQUIPMENT IS INSTALLED FOR AN EXISTING RESIDENCE, AN INSPECTION IS REQUIRED ON ONLY THAT PART OF THE WIRING INSTALLATION THAT IS NEW.
- (C) WHEN ELECTRICAL WIRING IS INSTALLED IN AN EXISTING RESIDENCE, AND NEW SERVICE EQUIPMENT IS NOT INSTALLED, AN INSPECTION IS **NOT** REQUIRED.

ELECTRICAL LICENSE REQUIRED FOR RESIDENTIAL WIRING

- (2) In addition to all Commercial, Industrial, and Public-Use installations, a valid electrical license will now be required to make electrical installations on all single-family residences, except for the following:
- (A) WILL NOT REQUIRE ANY PERSON HOLDING A CURRENT LICENSE ISSUED BY A BOARD APPROVED POLITICAL SUBDIVISION TO HOLD A STATE LICENSE WHILE INSTALLING WORK WITHIN THE JURISDICTIONAL LIMITS OF SUCH SUBDIVISION.
- (B) WILL NOT PROHIBIT AN OWNER OF PROPERTY FROM PERFORMING WORK ON HIS OR HER **PRINCIPAL RESIDENCE** OR REQUIRE SUCH OWNER TO BE LICENSED UNDER THE ACT.

A copy of the electrical inspection application will be sent to the power supplier.

DO NOT ENERGIZE A NEW SERVICE UNLESS YOU HAVE RECEIVED A COPY.

It shall be a Class I misdemeanor to fail or neglect to comply with the act or any lawful rule, regulation, or order of the State Electrical Board.
