The Council then considered the request from KelLee Osborne of Rubber Baby Buggy Bumpers Daycare to restrict the parking in front of her business at 218 S. River Street between the hours of 6:00am and 6:00pm for parent drop off and pick up. After discussion, it was moved by Smith and seconded by Swenson to table the matter at this time for further review. Voting Yea:

It was moved by Penrose and seconded by Stokely to accept the 2023 Title III-B Supportive Services Agreement, the Title III-C Nutrition Services Agreement and the Title III-E Family Caregiver Support Agreement with Northeast Nebraska Area Agency on Aging for the Sunshine Citizens Center. Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Swenson, Buse and Smith. Nay: None. Absent: Hugo. Motion carried.

Moved by Stokely, seconded by Penrose to approve closing the checking account at Wells Fargo Bank. Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Swenson, Buse and Smith. Nay: None. Absent: Hugo. Motion carried.

Tina Biteghe Bi Ndong, Executive Director of the West Point Chamber of Commerce, appeared before the Council and presented the quarterly report on the Chamber's economic development activities. Moved by Smith and seconded by Stokely to accept the report and approve the payment of \$5,000 for services April-June, 2022. Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Swenson, Buse and Smith. Nay: None. Absent: Hugo. Motion carried.

Moved by Swenson, seconded by Buse to approve the following application for a Special Designated Liquor Permit: Petro Mart for a Knights of Columbus Fish Fry on July 25, 2022 at GACC Cafeteria. Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Swenson, Buse and Smith. Nay: None. Absent: Hugo. Motion carried.

Moved by Smith, seconded by Stokely, to approve the claim of Hugo Plumbing & Heating for services and supplies in the amount of \$5,506.27. Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Swenson, Buse and Smith. Nay: None. Absent: Hugo. Motion carried.

The Mayor requested that the August Council meeting be rescheduled from Tuesday, August 2nd to Thursday, August 4th with the time remaining at 5:30 PM. The Council had no objection to this change.

Moved by Smith, seconded by Penrose, to hold a workshop for the 2022-2023 budget on Wednesday, July 27th at 4:30 PM. Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Swenson, Buse and Smith. Nay: None. Absent: Hugo. Motion carried.

Smith introduced Ordinance No. 1431 entitled:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEST POINT, NEBRASKA ADOPTING A PAY PLAN FOR CERTAIN OFFICERS AND ALL EMPLOYEES; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1426 AND ALL OTHER MOTIONS, RESOLUTIONS AND ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; PRESCRIBING THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FORCE AND TAKE EFFECT; AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE IN PAMPHLET FORM,

and moved that the statutory rule requiring reading on three different days be suspended. Swenson seconded the motion. Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Swenson, Buse and Smith. Nay: None. Absent: Hugo. Motion carried. Statutory rule suspended. Buse moved for final passage of the ordinance, which motion was seconded by Swenson. Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Swenson, Buse and Smith. Nay: None. Absent: Hugo. Ordinance adopted.

Next the Council considered the conveyance of real estate to Cuming County Economic Development. The purpose of this conveyance is for the demolition of the dilapidated structures on the property. Buse introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST POINT, NEBRASKA, CONVEYING THE ACQUIRED PROPERTY AT 128 E. GROVE STREET TO CUMING COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, INC.

Stokely seconded the motion. Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Swenson, Buse and Smith. Nay: None. Absent: Hugo. Motion carried and said resolution adopted.

The next agenda item was to discuss the potential purchase of real estate. It was moved by Smith, seconded by Buse to go into closed session at 6:05 PM for the protection of the public interest to discuss the potential purchase of real estate. Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Swenson, Buse and Smith. Nay: None. Absent: Hugo. Motion carried. The Mayor then restated for the record the limitation of the subject matter of the closed session was for the protection of the public interest to discuss the potential purchase of real estate. At 6:14 PM the Mayor stated that the closed session had ended and that the only item discussed during the closed session was the potential purchase of real estate and that the Council was back in regular session.

Moved by Swenson, seconded by Smith, to adjourn at 6:16 P.M. Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Swenson, Buse and Smith. Absent: Hugo. Nay: None. Motion carried.
